Subj: 2016 NSCC SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Ref: (a) NSCC Regulations, Chapter Sixteen

1. **Purpose.** To announce the Naval Sea Cadet Corps 2016 Scholarship Program.
2. **Background.** Reference (a) contains basic information on the annual scholarships offered by the Naval Sea Cadet Corps.
3. **Applications.** A new web-based application system is being used for the first time this year and all applicants will apply online. The application window will open at the beginning of March. We encourage applicants to prepare their package by working on the following:
  - a. All applicants will be required to provide an essay on their personal objectives and goals. This essay should answer the following question: "In 200 to 400 words, tell us about how you plan to translate what you learned and achieved in the Sea Cadet program to your future goals."
  - b. All applicants will be required to provide a scanned copy of their acceptance letter to the accredited university, college or technical school that they intend to attend.
  - c. All applicants will be required to request endorsements from their unit commanding officer and two other personal and academic references through the application system.
  - d. All applicants will be required to upload a copy of their transcripts.
  - e. All applicants will be required to provide their cumulative scores from the SAT and/or ACT.
