| 1 | Bugspray (non-aerosol) |
| 1 | Sunscreen (non-aerosol) |
| 1 | Medications (both Rx and over-the-counter) – in original container – in Ziploc bag labeled with cadet's name and dosage – must be submitted to Medical Officer upon check-in |
| 1 | No contraband: including electronics (video games, iPads, iPods, etc), firearms, matches/ lighters, tobacco of any kind, alcohol/drugs. <u>Cell phones MUST be checked in upon arrival.</u> Any of these above listed items will be confiscated and only returned to parents. |
