#### **NOTES**

- DRESS UNIFORMS: All cadet uniforms MUST be cleaned, ironed, hemmed, and properly flashed for the Veterans Day Parade on Saturday. The temperature will be in the 50's, so cadets are welcome to wear extra layers under their dress uniform, just make sure it doesn't show above the uniform.
- PRTs: Physical Readiness Training assessments are required twice a year. All cadets are required to complete this assessment, regardless of whether or not they will be attending a winter training.
- **VETERANS DAY PARADE:** Downtown Lexington, Sat 1400. Parents are to pick up their cadet AT THE PARADE LOCATION.
- ID / POD: All cadets should have a POD and their current Sea Cadet ID card in their pocket at all times.
