NOTES

- SATURDAY:** Three projects: 1) selling sponsorship of Christmas Wreaths for veterans to the community - to be placed at Camp Nelson Cemetery during December's drill, 2) Physical Readiness Testing (PRT) – required annually for Boot Camp & Advanced Trainings, 3) distribution of Dress Blues to all cadets who have not yet received them. All cadets should work on their uniforms Saturday evening to prepare for Sunday's inspection (refer to the Uniform Manual).
- SUNDAY:** All cadets should wear Dress Blues to drill on Sunday in preparation for December's Christmas Banquet. Cadets with Dress Blues must provide their own white t-shirts.
- RECRUIT DRESS UNIFORM:** The dress uniform for New Recruits is black pants, white long-sleeved button-down dress shirt, white t-shirt, black socks, black dress shoes. League Cadets and New Recruits are responsible for purchasing the items for their dress uniform. (These are generic items that can be purchased from Walmart, Target, etc.)
- DON'T FORGET:** All cadets and staff should have their USNSCC ID card and a copy of the POD in their uniform pocket at all times.
